SUBJECT: FY 2021 BRYNE –JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANTS ANNOUNCEMENT OF FUNDS

Red River Delta Law Enforcement Planning Council, Inc. is the organization responsible for allocating federal funding through Bureau of Justice Assistance for the Byrne - Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG). The federal amount available to the Red River Delta District is as follows:

Byrne – Justice Assistance Grant Funds, FY 2021 – \$168,906

Red River Delta is required to adopt an actual listing of projects to be funded with these monies. Please give some immediate consideration to types of projects you are interested in continuing or developing.

Please follow the instructions below to submit an allocation request for FY 2021 JAG funds.

- 1) Please note: Request should be calculated based on **12 MONTHS**.
- 2) Visit our website, www.rrdnw.com.
- 3) Click either the RRD logo, OR, click the Red River Delta district, highlighted orange, in the map on the left.
- 4) Under the “\$ Funding” tab, click the “Available Funds” button. You may also access the page by going to the following link: <http://rrdnw.com/rrd/rrd-funding/>.
- 5) Under the section titled “BJAG – FY 2021” you will find the *JAG General Information* form for important information along with the required documents.
- 6) Complete the appropriate request forms for each project; *JAG Allocation Request Form*, *JAG Notice of Intent*, *RRD Application Information Form*, and *Conflict of Interest Forms* (for the Authorized Official, Project Director, Financial Officer, and the person responsible for grants, if different from the listed officials). Also, JAG requires all subrecipients to submit a properly-executed “Certification of Compliance with 8 U.S.C. § 1373” before Red River Delta may allocate funds to an agency. This requirement applies to all awards (at any tier) to units of local government, including subawards required or authorized by statute, but it will not apply to subawards to Indian tribes.
- 7) After completing and signing the forms, scan & email the forms to Hailey Nalezinek at Hailey@rrdnw.com, then mail the signed originals to our office **no later than Friday, May 13th, 2022**. Any request submitted after this date will be placed on file for the FY 2022 funds.

The Red River Delta Project Priority Committee will be meeting on **Thursday, July 6th, 2022 at 2:00pm** at Red River Delta, 615 Main St., Pineville, LA 71360 to hear proposals. A representative from your agency is required and must present a brief explanation of your proposal to be eligible for funding. No funds will be allocated to an agency without a representative present.
