Red River Delta Law Enforcement Planning Council, Inc. is the organization responsible for allocating federal funding through the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention for the Title II Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (JJDP) formula grant program. The federal amount available to the Northwest District is as follows:

**Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (JJDP), FY 2021 – (estimated) \$46,000**

Red River Delta LEPC, Inc. is required to allocate these funds to one program. Please give some immediate consideration to types of projects you are interested in continuing or developing.

To streamline the application process, please follow the instructions below to submit an allocation request for FY 2021 JJDP funds.

- 4) Complete the appropriate request forms for each project; *JJDP Allocation Request Form*, *JJDP Notice of Intent*, *RRD Application Information Form*, and *Conflict of Interest Forms* (for the Authorized Official, Project Director, Financial Officer, and the person responsible for grants, if different from the listed officials)
- 5) After completing and signing the forms, scan & email the forms to Hailey Nalezinek at [Hailey@rrdnw.com](mailto:Hailey@rrdnw.com), then mail the signed originals to our office **no later than Friday, August 5, 2022**. Any request submitted after this date will be placed on file for the FY 2022 funds.

The Red River Delta Project Priority Committee will be meeting on **Thursday September 1, 2022 at 1:30pm** at 615 Main St., Pineville, LA 71360 to hear proposals. A representative from your agency is required and must present a brief explanation of your proposal to be eligible for funding. No funds will be allocated to an agency without a representative present.
