SUBJECT: FY 2021 VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT (VOCA) GRANT

Attention all law enforcement agencies and local service providers,

Red River Delta Law Enforcement Planning Council is the organization responsible for allocating Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) funding through the Office of Victims of Crime and the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement. The federal amount available to the Red River Delta District is as follows:

Victim of Crim Act, FY 2021– \$1,083,960

Red River Delta LEPC, Inc. is required to adopt an actual listing of projects to be funded with these monies. Please give some immediate consideration to types of projects you are interested in continuing or developing.

In an effort to streamline the application process, please follow the instructions below to submit an allocation request for FY 2021 VOCA funds.

- 1) **Please Note: Requests should be calculated based on 6 MONTHS (4/1/23- 9/31/23).**
- 2) Visit our website, www.rrdnw.com.
- 3) Click either the RRD logo, OR, click the Red River Delta district, highlighted orange, in the map on the left.
- 4) Under the "\$ Funding" tab, click the "Available Funds" button. You may also access the page by clicking the following link: <http://rrdnw.com/rrd/rrd-funding> Choose the section titled, "VOCA – FY 2021 (6 Months)".
- 5) Complete the appropriate request forms for each project; *VOCA Notice of Intent*, *VOCA Allocation Request Form*, *RRD Application Information Form*, and *Conflict of Interest Forms* (for the Authorized Official, Project Director, Financial Officer, and the person responsible for grants, if different from the listed officials).
PLEASE NOTE: LCLE, with district approval, will sometimes allow partial, or full, match waivers based on the agency's budget and means to come up with matching funds. If applicable to your agency, please contact the district office for details.
- 6) After completing and signing the forms, mail the signed originals to our office **no later than Friday, August 5, 2022**. Any request submitted after this date will be placed on file for the FY 2022 funds.

The Red River Delta Project Priority Committee will be meeting on **Thursday, September 1, 2022 at 1:30 pm** at 615 Main St., Pineville, LA 71360 to hear proposals. A representative from your agency is required and must present a brief explanation of your proposal to be eligible for funding. No funds will be allocated to an agency without a representative present.
