SUBJECT: FY 2022 BRYNE –JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANTS ANNOUNCEMENT OF FUNDS

Northwest Law Enforcement Planning Agency Inc. is the organization responsible for allocating federal funding through Bureau of Justice Assistance for the Byrne - Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG). The anticipated federal amount available to the Northwest District is as follows:

Byrne – Justice Assistance Grant Funds, FY 2022 – \$202,138 (Estimated)

Northwest is required to adopt an actual listing of projects to be funded with these monies. Please give some immediate consideration to types of projects you are interested in continuing or developing.

Please follow the instructions below to submit an allocation request for FY 2021 JAG funds.

- 1) Please note: Request should be calculated based on **12 MONTHS**.
- 2) Visit our website, www.rrdnw.com.
- 3) Click either the NW logo, OR, click the Northwest district, highlighted grey, in the map on the left.
- 4) Under the "\$ Funding" tab, click the "Available Funds" button. You may also access the page by going to the following link: <http://rrdnw.com/northwest/nw-funding/>.
- 5) Under the section titled "BJAG – FY 2022" you will find the *JAG General Information* form for important information along with the required documents.
- 6) Complete the appropriate request forms for each project; *JAG Applicant Information Form*, *JAG Notice of Intent*, and *Conflict of Interest Forms* (for the Authorized Official, Project Director, Financial Officer, and any person associated with the grant, if different from the listed officials), if different from the listed officials).
- 7) After completing and signing the forms in blue ink, scan & email the forms in color to our office at programs@rrdnw.com **no later than Friday, July 14th, 2023**. Since LCLE no longer requires original signatures, please **DO NOT MAIL ORIGINALS**. Keep the originals for your records Any request submitted after this date will be placed on file for the FY 2023 funds.

The Northwest Project Priority Committee will be meeting on **Thursday, August 10th, 2023 at 10:00 am** at the North Louisiana Crime Lab, 1630 Tulane Avenue, Shreveport LA 71103 to hear proposals. A representative from your agency is required and must present a brief explanation of your proposal to be eligible for funding. No funds will be allocated to an agency without a representative present.
