Please follow the instructions below to submit an allocation request for FY 2025 JAG funds.

- 1) **Please note: Requests should be calculated based on 12 MONTHS.**
- 2) Visit our website, www.rrdnw.com.
- 3) Click either the NW logo, OR, click the blue Northwest district in the map on the right.
- 4) Under the “Funding” tab, click the “Available Funds” button. You may also access the page by typing the following link in the web browser: <https://rrdnw.com/nw/available-funds>. Choose the section titled, “FY 2025 JAG”.
- 5) Complete the appropriate request documents for each project: *JAG Notice of Intent*, *JAG Applicant Information Form*, and *Conflict of Interest Forms* (for the Authorized Official, Project Director, Financial Officer, the person responsible for grants, and any person listed on the grant, if different).
- 6) After completing and having the authorized official sign the request documents in blue ink, upload the documents on our website using the submission form at the following link: <https://rrdnw.com/nw/allocation-request> **no later than Friday July 17, 2026**. Any request submitted after this date will not be on the agenda for the Project Priority Committee Meeting.

The Northwest Project Priority Committee will be meeting on **Tuesday, August 25th, 2026 at 10:00 am** at the North Louisiana Crime Lab, 1630 Tulane Avenue, Shreveport LA 71103 to hear proposals. A representative from your agency is required and must present a brief explanation of your proposal to be eligible for funding. No funds will be allocated to an agency without a representative present.
